## **OUR HISTORY**

Samsi college, the second oldest institution of Higher Education in the district of Malda and the first one in North Malda subdivision, was established on the 25th August, 1968 by its organizing Committee headed by the organizing President Sri Kamalakar Misra (I.A.S & District Magistrate, Malda) and its organizing Secretary Sri Sunil Kr. Misra (B.D.O., Ratua). Considering the constraints on Higher Education of students of North Malda, the said District Magistrate Sri kamalakar Misra proposed in 1967 the establishment of a College at Samsi. The eminent personalities of and around Samsi took constructive steps for this by donating money and land. The next year the College came in reality with its formal opening of classes on the 14th oct, 1968 at Samsi Agril High School. Within two years of its establishment, the College was able to construct its own temporary mud-building at the present site in the peaceful and natural environment of the historically place of Kandaran. The College is encircled and well-protected by a boundary wall and has a big play- ground, a boy's hostel, a Girl's Hostel and a pond for physicculture. More than 5000 students from the neighboring area and different districts of west Bengal study now in this College kandaran, the site of the College, has immensely historical and archaeological significance. It is a place where ancient and medieval chapters of history meet and where Hindus, Muslims & Christians live together in mutual understanding and communal brotherhood fostered by the College. A number of English medium schools have also been established around the College. On account of completing glorious 50 years, Samsi College celebrated its Golden Jubilee from 17<sup>th</sup> to 19<sup>th</sup> December 2018.

## **Class attendance**

Attendance in classes is a must for all newly admitted students. A student who absents himself / herself from one or more classes will lose the day's attendance. Any student who is absent for one month continuously without sufficient reason will have his / her name removed from the College register. A student must have 75% class attendance to be eligible to appear in the Semester / University Examination as a regular candidate for B.A. 4-Year UG Degree (Honours / Honours with Research) and B. Com 4-Year UG Degree Course as per Supreme Court Order and UGB Circular.

### **ADMISSION RULES**

Admission to B.A. 4-Year UG Degree (Honours / Honours with Research) and B. Com 4-Year UG Degree Course in 1<sup>st</sup> Semester

All admission will be made as per regulations of University of Gour Banga. All admissions are provisional, subject to verification and rejection in case of any discrepancy found in the filled in online application form.

- The application form will be automatically rejected if the candidates fail the following Eligible criteria.
  - (i) 4-Year UG Degree (Honours / Honours with Research): A student who has passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) Examination held by the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent Examination from other Boards / Councils with at least four subjects having English as Compulsory Subject of 100 marks is eligible to take admission to the Honours Programmes of Studies of B.A./B.Sc./B.Com./B.C.A. on the basis of merit and available vacancy of the particular subject(s) of the concerned college.
  - (ii) 4-Year UG Degree: A student who has passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) Examination held by the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent Examination from other Boards/Councils with at least four subjects having English as Compulsory Subject of 100 marks is eligible to take admission to the General Programmes of Studies of B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. on the basis of merit and available vacancy of the particular subject(s) of the concerned college.
  - (iii) A student who has passed Higher Secondary (10+2) examinations (with English as a subject) of the West Bengal State Council of Technical & Vocational Education and Skill Development or any equivalent Courses from National or State Level Board in regular mode shall be eligible as per norms of University of Gour Banga.
  - (iv) NRI: In case of any NRI applicant the College Authority should seek permission from the University Authority as well as from appropriate Authority.
  - (v) Students who have passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) Examinations in the current year, immediate previous year and the year before the previous year will only be allowed to take admission.
  - (vi) Aggregate marks shall be calculated by adding the marks in top-four subjects, including Marks obtained in English, in order of marks secured by a candidate. Marks obtained in Compulsory Environmental Studies (if any) shall not be taken into account for calculation of aggregate marks.
  - (Vii) There shall be reservation of seats for SC / ST / OBC-A /OBC-B and Differently-abled Candidates as per Rules of the State Government. 22% seats for SC, 6% seats for ST,10% seats for OBC-A,7% seats for OBC-B and 10% seats for the Economically Weaker Section(EWS) are reserved.
  - (Viii) A candidate shall be allowed to pursue any one of the Programmes in a particular Academic Session. At the initial stage, every student has to choose one Major subject(Honours Subject) and two Minor subjects (Generic Elective subjects ) along with MIL compulsory subjects (Bengali / English).

- ix) If a student is not able to pursue 4-Year UG Degree (Honours / Honours with Research) during the course, then he/she may convert the above mentioned course into 4-Year UG Degree Course before the UGB Registration process in the 1<sup>st</sup> Semester according to College authority permission.
- x) Admitted students would have to fill out the University Registration Form with the payment of Rs. 300/during the provided time of UGB, but if the students fail to do the UGB Registration during the provided time of UGB, then they will have to pay an extra of Rs.100/- as a late fine for doing the same.

## The selection criteria and merit will be prepared as per the provisions of the University. The Merit Point Calculation will be done as follows:

a) Subject to the eligibility criteria, the merit lists for the 4-Year UG Degree (Honours /Honours with Research) Courses will be prepared as:

- i) Merit Point Calculation:
  - (a) Subject to the eligibility criteria, the merit lists for the Honours Programme will be prepared as:(i) (S+T)/4

[Where S = Subject marks (opted for Honours Programme) and T = Marks obtained in English + best marks of two other subjects (excluding subject opted for Honours Programme].

(ii) In case, any candidate opts for an Honours Programme beyond his/her subject combination

[except linguistic subjects at H.S. (10+2) level], the merit point will be calculated as: T1/4 [Where T1 = Marks obtained in English + best marks of three other subjects (excluding English)].

b) Subject to the eligibility criteria, the merit lists for the General Programme will be prepared as: T1/4

[Where T1 = Marks obtained in English + best marks of three other subjects (excluding English)]

ii) **Special conditions for admission:** A student shall be allowed to take up a subject in Honours /General Programme if he /she has passed in that subject at the previous qualifying examination subject to some exceptions for specified subjects. #### THE COLLEGE LIBRARY

Minority students also get various scholarships.

COLLEGE MAGAZINE / WALL MAGAZINE

The college magazine is published once a year under the aegis of the College Authority and every student is entitled to a copy of it. Students get opportunity to give expression to their creative talents through writings in the magazines. Wall magazines are also published on different occasions.

#### FULL FREE & HALF FREE STUDENTSHIP

Concessions in tuition fees in the form of Full free and half free studentship are awarded to the students of the college on the basis of merit, conduct, performance in co-curricular activities including sports, cultural and extension activities as well as their financial condition. For this purpose, application along with income certificates and mark-sheets / certificates of previous examination, are to be submitted to the college office every year following notification by the principal. A selection committee will verify the applications conduct take interviews with applicants. The students with poor % of class attendance or who do not appear in the full free and half free studentship.
